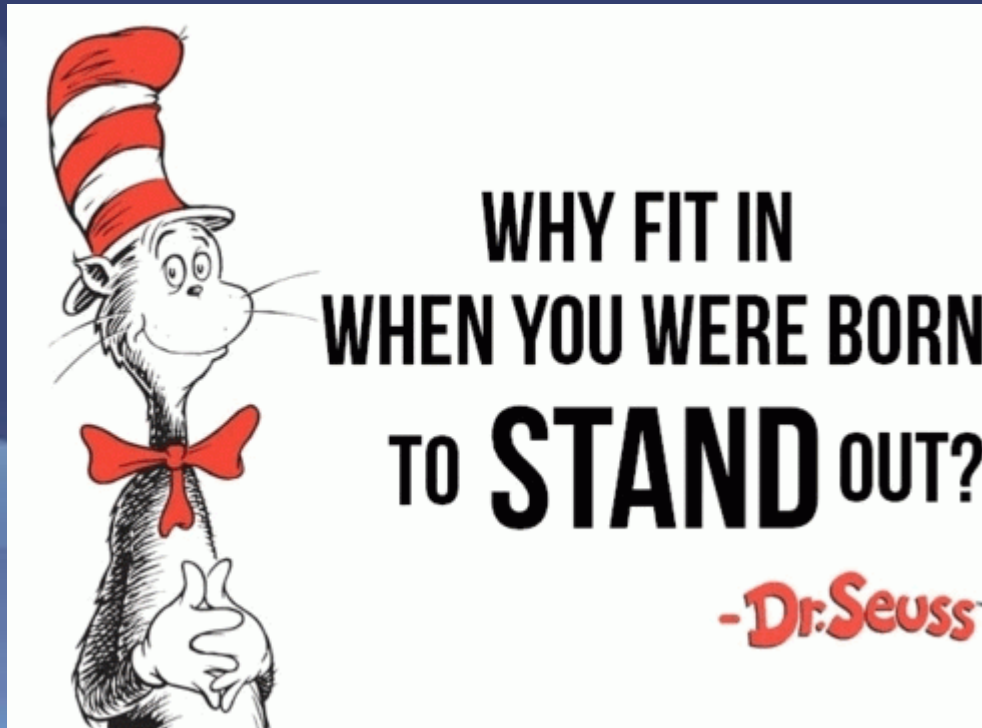

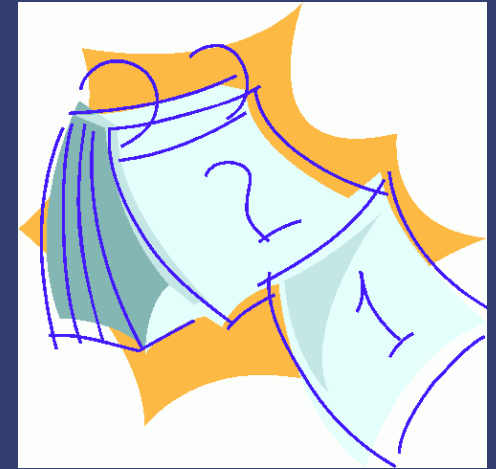

  - Good moral character and pass a background/fingerprint check

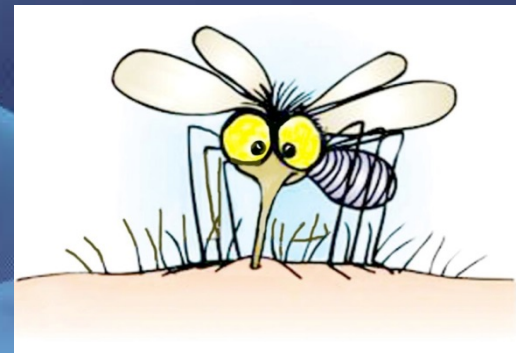
