**SUBJECT: ATTENDANCE BOUNDARY COMMITTEE (ABC) NOTIFICATION OF FINAL TARGETED SCHOOLS**

The Attendance Boundary Committee (ABC) finalized its list of targeted/advised schools. Each targeted school listed needs to be closely reviewed for potential boundary and/or grade configuration modifications. The next step of the process requires that the targeted school communities attend region community meetings where proposed recommendations are presented. In order to develop viable solutions, community input will be solicited at these meetings.

The Region Center Superintendents are charged with the responsibility of ensuring that these steps are followed:

- Every principal informs their Student Leaders, Educational Excellence School Advisory Council (EESAC) and the Parent Teacher Association/Parent Teacher Student Association (PTA/PTSA) President/Chairperson, of the schools on the ABC 2016-2017 List of Final Targeted and Final Advised Schools.
- Targeted schools must make every effort to ensure that the students, parents and their school community/neighborhood at-large are notified of the meetings and the proposed recommendations. Connect-ED messages should be sent to parents in the targeted schools. Notices should be posted at the school, on the marquee, at local businesses, churches, community organizations, homeowners' associations and/or other locations as deemed appropriate for the particular community. Additionally, notices should be submitted to community newspapers and/or *The Miami Herald Neighbors*.
- Region Center Superintendents and principals must make every reasonable effort to cooperate with individuals and/or community groups to assist them in developing proposed recommendations.
- Region Center Superintendents are responsible for providing any data regarding enrollment figures, transported students, spot maps, etc., to all interested individuals and/or community groups.

- All recommendations must be submitted to the appropriate Region Center Superintendent **no later than 12:00 noon, Friday, February 10, 2017. No recommendations submitted after this deadline will be accepted.**

These steps are essential in order to have maximum involvement by all affected citizens in the process. Every effort must be made to ensure that affected communities are involved at the school level.
