Good Morning,



- ✚ School begins on August 20st at 7:20 AM. We ask that students arrive no later than 7:00 AM on the first day so they may orient themselves to the campus and locate the room for their first period class. Students should arrive no later than 7:10 AM thereafter to ensure prompt arrival to class.
- ✚ The construction on NE 151 Street will continue for some time. Keep in mind that there are two high schools, one K-8 school, one alternative school and a university along 151 Street, so traffic congestion is high at arrival and dismissal. If you reach Biscayne Boulevard and 151 Street before 7:00 AM you will encounter little or no traffic congestion.
- ✚ Parents driving to the Biscayne Bay campus should enter the campus through the main entrance and then turn right at the sign that indicates the location of MAST@FIU. Drive east toward Academic 2 until you reach the round-about in Parking lot #2.
- ✚ Remember that breakfast is free for all students. Breakfast is available from 6:45 AM-7:15 AM each day.
- ✚ Students arriving on campus prior to 7:20 AM should congregate in open area around the center stairwell in Academic 1 so they may socialize and enjoy a free breakfast before class.
- ✚ Remember that our uniform policy specifies the following:
 - Black, blue or Khaki pants, blue jeans are allowed, and our polo logo shirt.
 - Closed shoes are required; no sandals or flip flops are permitted.
 - Sweaters, hoodies or other apparel may not be worn over the polo shirt unless the item has our school logo.
 - All returning students must wear their school ID. New students will receive a temporary ID to wear until they receive their permanent ID.

- ✚ Student schedules should be posted on the parent and student portals today. Make sure your child has a copy or takes a picture of his or her schedule to use on the first day of school. A person will be located on the first floor at 7:00 AM to assist students who do not know their first period room number.

- ✚ Students who completed FLVS or Dual Enrollment courses over the summer recess will receive a form to complete during first period on August 20th so schedules may be adjusted quickly. Many students have a FLVS course listed in their schedule to accommodate this change.
- ✚ We will address any problems that students observe with their schedules in an orderly process beginning on the first day of school. Our first priority is to make sure that the students in Dual Enrollment and Advanced Placement courses are scheduled appropriately. That process will consume all of Monday. Students will not be allowed to leave class to address schedule concerns. After we finish with the first two groups, we will address schedule concerns by grade level beginning with seniors, then juniors, etc. We hope to address all concerns within a short period of time. Please be patient.
- ✚ Students will receive various forms on day one. Some forms require your signature. Please ask your child for these forms so they may be returned quickly to homeroom teachers.
- ✚ Parents, please remember that only the persons who you have listed on your child's Emergency Contact card are authorized to sign-out your child during the school day. You must contact Ms. Hennessey or Ms. West personally if you wish to make a change.
