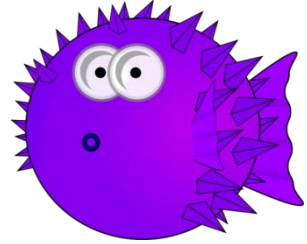


Update 8.8.17

Good Afternoon,

- ✚ We are in the process of accessing our incoming 9th and rising 10th grade students to determine who is eligible for DE this year. Many students participated in today's administration of the PERT and another session is scheduled for tomorrow.
- ✚ Remember that our uniform policy specifies the following:
 - Black, blue or Khaki pants, blue jeans are allowed, and our polo logo shirt.
 - Closed shoes are required; no sandals or flip flops are permitted.
 - Sweaters, hoodies or other apparel may not be worn over the polo shirt unless the item has our school logo.
