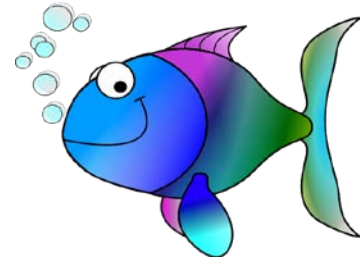


Update 9.24.18
